New External Adjudicators for the Alexander Maconochie Centre

The ACT Government is seeking Expressions of Interest for two additional External Adjudicators to provide greater transparency and independent review of Alexander Maconochie Centre (AMC) operations.

The External Adjudicators provide an independent review of disciplinary matters and segregation decisions that are disputed by detainees in the AMC.

The Adjudicators support other independent review functions, including the Inspector of Custodial Services, Human Rights Commission and Official Visitors, and play a vital role in ensuring the rights of detainees at the AMC are upheld.

ACT Corrective Services is now seeking an additional two adjudicators to bring more diversity of experience to the role and to ensure an Adjudicator is available across holiday periods or unexpected resignations.

The Adjudicator is paid a per diem of \$540 (as at March 2019). The role requires an appointee to be judicially qualified. A judicially qualified person is either a judge or retired judge; a magistrate or retired magistrate; or a person who has been a legal practitioner for not less than five years.
